## Parents/Guardians (and other family members) Code of Conduct

- Set a good example by respecting the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- If anything happens that you are concerned about,, please encourage the player to tell one of the coaching staff, organisers or another adult.
- Publicly accept and respect officials and their decisions.
- Encourage your player to learn the rules and play within them.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
- Teach and support the player in recognising the importance of effort and teamwork.
- Encourage players to follow and recognise the **RICE** principles (**R**esilience, **I**ntensity, **C**ompetitive, **E**nergy).
- Support players to contribute positively to the culture of the club by displaying **PSP** (**P**ositive body language, **S**peed, **P**ositive touches).
- The club welcomes encouragement of players at games but requests that you leave all matters of coaching advice to the coaching staff.
