Players Code of Conduct

- Treat everyone how you would like to be treated- never deliberately upset a team-mate or someone in your training group. Bullying will not be accepted.
- All players must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- All players must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All players must wear suitable kit for training and games, as agreed with the Coach/Team Manager.
- All players should tell their Coach if they have an injury or feel unwell.
- If anything happens that a player is concerned about, whether it relates to them or to someone else, they must make sure they tell one of the coaching staff, organisers or another adult.
- All players must follow the **RICE** principles (**R**esilience, **I**ntensity, **C**ompetitive, **E**nergy).
- All players must follow the culture of the club by displaying **PSP** (**P**ositive body language, **S**peed, **P**ositive touches).
